- Review of PNA Assessment (CASA) Grouped viewed data and question types
- Shows the need of SIP Goal #4
- CASA survey
- ♣ Surveyed: 6th grade students, 26; 7th grade students, 148; 8th grade students, 132; 9th grade students, 134; 10th grade students, 96
- Drugs and Alcohol prevention, DFC Funding has allowed for focus in this are



- CASA has worked collaboratively with other agencies
- Examples of the types of questions that were on the Survey:
- ◆ 1 to 14 times touching alcohol in life time
- ♣ In the past 30 days
- Other questions about current marijuana use
- ♣ Before the age of 13 use of alcohol and marijuana
- Shannon Funding allows for work on gang prevention and as a result gang involvement is down
- ♣ Physical fights at WHS → inside or outside of school
- Bullying on school property or Cyber bullying
- ♣ Unwanted or forced sex → 12th grade high, low 8th
- Sexual behavior and gender expression
- ♣ We have data from 8th 12th grade
- ♣ According to the survey 47% of students who had had sex did so before the age of 15
- ♣ By 12th grade 47% have had sexual intercourse
- ♣ Sexual Minorities → transgender not heterosexual
- There were also questions about sex and alcohol and drug use
- Sex and protection
- Mental health issues
- Great concern to all of CASA Board and staf



- Youth Advisory board
- ♣ Suicide Attempt made a plan suicide ideation sad and hopeless for at least 2 weeks
- Adjustment councilors at schools
- Question about HS students who seriously considered suicide
- ♣ The acronym CASA = Community Action for Safe Alternatives
